Subject: Businesses, Cities and Civil Society Organisations Support Swift and Ambitious Action to Decarbonise Corporate Fleets

Dear Commissioner Tzitzikostas,

We, businesses, cities and civil society organizations, are writing to you ahead of the High-Level Strategic Dialogue on Decarbonizing Corporate Fleets. At a time when protecting the environment and supporting the electric transition is challenged by many, we wish to express our broad support for swift and ambitious legislation to decarbonise light and heavy duty vehicles in corporate fleets.

To truly deliver on this potential, we strongly encourage you to come forward with a **Regulation** that:

- Accelerates corporate car electrification, reaching at least an overall EU electrification rate of 90% (new registrations of corporate cars) by 2030, and
- Sets binding zero-emission shipment targets by 2030 for large cargo owners. This approach places the responsibility where the purchasing power lies, ensuring demand for zero-emission freight solutions.

These measures are vital to achieving the EU's climate objectives and fostering a competitive, sustainable European economy. This proposal directly supports the Commission's ambition to create robust lead markets for cleantech products, ensuring that European innovation in electric mobility finds strong domestic demand. Clear and stable regulatory signals will unlock the necessary investments and drive innovation in the transport sector.
